### So, what is an HOA?

HOAs are commonly established as a non-profit corporation governed by a set of documents including the Articles of Incorporation, the Bylaws, and the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CCRs). Home values are maintained through the enforcement of community standards spelled out in these governing documents. Generally most standards focus on property maintenance and architectural design of the community.

A Board of Directors is elected to oversee the funds of the community and enforce the Bylaws. They approve contracts, set the budget, enforce the documents and oversee committees.

Finally, a property management company works with the board, handling all the day to day operations of the association, including budgeting and financials, requesting RFPs and paying invoices, common area maintenance, amenity and vendor management, violations to governing document standards, collections, and association meetings.

# Who you gonna call...

#### Association Responsibility

- HOA budget management, dues and fees
- Common area maintenance, including association pools, parks, fences and walls
- Architectural modifications to exterior of owner properties as regulated by CC&Rs
- Landscaping, flags, signage, and lawn art as outlined in CC&Rs

#### City Responsibility

- Public properties, including streets, lights, sidewalks, curbs, and drains
- Permits, trash and watering rules
- City ordinances, neighbor disturbances, animal control (and animal feces) issues, and illegal business operations
- Traffic enforcement, city laws, and parking enforcement on public streets and thoroughfares

## The Farmer's Guide to Roofing Season

Whether you have lived in Texas all your life or are a newcomer, you are probably familiar with the different hunting seasons around us. These can include deer, pheasant, alligator, or rabbit, but for this article I want to address one of these seasons specifically and how you can "hunt" responsibly; Roofing Season.

For the months of May-August it is open season on roofs. Mother Nature has been known to unleash furious winds and aggressive hail and it is our job as homeowners to hunt these wild predators down. This guide will help you better understand what you can do during roofing season to keep yourself and your neighbors protected.

#### **Conditions**

 When preparing to get your roof worked on you will want to ensure to avoid potential inclement weather.
 Check the forecast and plan accordingly.

#### Gear

 As your roof or the roof around you is getting done you will need to be extra vigilant about closed toed shoes and looking out for rogue nails on the sidewalks as well in the road.

#### **Navigation**

- Roofers come with large trucks to carry the materials and can cause our streets to become narrow, be prepared to take alternate routes in and around the neighborhood.
- Always be aware of your surroundings, there have been sightings of runaways trailers!

#### **Field Dressing**

 Debris from the workers may float around the streets and your yard, you should pick these up as you notice them to keep our field looking nice.

#### Off-Season

 During the off season you can help prevent another extensive roofing season by being mindful of low-hanging or extending branches that can impact yours or others roofs and/or windows.
